Maynard Ferguson had a tremendous influence on trumpet players around the world. At the same time his style of big band jazz was also making headlines. For this special night, Dave Stahl has assembled an All-Star Big Band that replicates Maynard's early instrumentation. After his historic Hollywood studio tenure, Maynard formed his own band that later became the appropriately titled Birdland Dream Band. Your parents may remember traveling to the Starlight Ballroom in Hershey or the Sunnybrook Ballroom in Pottstown to hear this hot new band. Join us as we recreate that energy!

New York City elite coming in for this show include **Alex Bender**, **Andy Gravish** and **Marty Bound** on trumpet, **John Mosca** on trombone, **Chris Bacas** and **Brandon Wright** on tenor sax plus **Frank Basile** on bari sax. From the Pocono's, Maynard Ferguson alumnus **Nelson Hill** will be with us on alto sax as well as **Chuck Dressler** on trombone. From Dave's rhythm section **John Riley** will be on drums, **Ron Stabinsky** on piano and **Tim Wolfe** on bass.

We know many of you were fans of Maynard and had the opportunity to hear him often. Should you have any memorabilia (pictures, shirts, publications, etc.) that you would like to share with us, please bring them along. We will have space next to the CD sales area for the display. Stop there before, during intermission or afterwards to share your own Maynard story.

Directions – If you have not been to the Hebron Events Facility, it is a little tricky. East Walnut Street is Route 422 East and it is a one-way street. (Route 422 splits in Lebanon with 422 West being Cumberland Street). Once on East Walnut Street, look for cross streets that are Avenues. Just past 6th Avenue, get into the left lane and slow down! The Hebron Events Facility is on your left and is behind the Hebron Hose Company. Turn just before the fire station. Parking is in the rear.
